## PUBLIC QUESTION TO BE VOTED UPON

### EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Board is proposing to undertake security, safety, health and facilities upgrades to the school as follows:

- school entry security, communication and handicap/ADA upgrades and renovations;
- interior and exterior door replacements and upgrades for security, accessibility and energy efficiency;
- roof replacement;
- fire alarm system replacement;
- replacement of water heaters, boilers and HVAC equipment and system controls with energy efficient systems;
- window replacement;
- site repair and regrading;
- toilet room upgrades;
- flooring and lighting replacement; and
- building envelope improvements.

The total project costs shall not exceed \$4,814,615. The Board has received an award of State funding (debt service aid) in the amount of 39.93% which State funding reduces the taxpayers' share of the project to 60.07%.

The State contribution will only be available if this Proposal is approved by the voters.

### PROPOSAL

The Board of Education of the Borough of Farmingdale in the County of Monmouth, New Jersey is authorized to undertake a school facilities project consisting of roof replacement; fire alarm system replacement; replacement of water heaters, boilers and HVAC equipment and system controls with energy efficient systems; security, communication and handicap/ADA upgrades and renovations; window replacement; site repair and regrading; interior and exterior door replacements and upgrades for security, accessibility and energy efficiency; toilet room upgrades; flooring and lighting replacement; and building envelope improvements. The Board is authorized to expend on such project and issue bonds for such project in an amount not to exceed \$4,814,615, thus using up \$506,796.89 of the \$4,565,537.70 borrowing margin of the Borough of Farmingdale previously available for other improvements. The State has agreed to provide debt service aid in the amount of 40% of the "final eligible costs" of the school facilities project. The project's "final eligible costs" are \$4,806,165.

### Instructions for Voting
